#### TAXONOMIC NOTES AND REMARKS

Although *Byasa dasarada barata* Rothschild was reported from Arunachal Pradesh by Arora, Adam Cotton states that it is not known from India.

*Papilio janaka* Moore: Adam Cotton treats this as a synonym of *Papilio bootes*. Breeding experiments with both *P. janaka* and *P. bootes* might confirm this.

*Papilio protenor protenor* Cramer, although mentioned by Evans (1932), is not found in India, but in China.

*Papilio bianor ganesa* Moore is only on E. Himalayan slopes.

*Papilio bianor gladiator* Fruhstorfer is known from the Khasi Hills (Meghalaya) and Manipur.

*Papilio prexaspes pitmani* Elwes & de Niceville is not found in India.
